Rules

The Regatta is organized under the authority of Buccaneer Yacht Club, and will be governed by the current edition of the [Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events (available at www.gya.org), the Notice of Race, and the Fish Class Rules, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

Specific rules for this regatta are contained in GYA Regulation 40.

Eligibility and Entry

The GYA Fish Class Championship is open to all GYA General Member Clubs. Notification has been made in accordance with GYA Reg 4.3. Boats will be provided by Buccaneer Yacht Club and individual owners. Each Club wishing to participate shall return their Application to Compete via email (mark.caraher@gawest.com) not later than October 15th, 2020. Results of the Competing Clubs Selection will be emailed not later than October 19th, 2020 to all Clubs returning Applications.

Note: One Skipper and Two crews are required for all Three Races.

Sailors can Skipper one race and Crew Two.

Courses

Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System (RRS A4) will be used; however no scores shall be excluded. This changes RRS A2. Three races are scheduled, one of which shall be completed to constitute a series. Ties will be resolved in accordance with GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events 25.2(a). This changes RRS A8.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in accordance with GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events 40.7 and 40.8.
